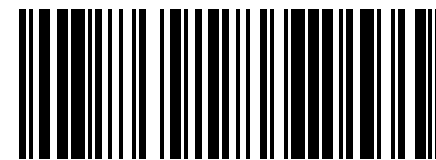
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove existing fascia and barge boards & ready the area for installation.
- Measure required length of fascia.
- Using a hacksaw (or any saw with a fine blade) cut the fascia to the required length.
- Attach the fascia board with the polytop nails.
- Repeat the process for the next board.
- If you need to join boards, make sure you measure from the inside of the connectors on either side of the gap you need to fill.
- Cut to size and snap into place.
- If possible, make each fascia board the same length
- When deciding where to position the joining connectors, try to centre an odd number of joints.
- Use the same procedure for the barge boards.
- Make sure you cut the ends of the barge board vertically.
- The joining connectors for the barge boards work the same as the fascia board connectors.
- At the apex of the roof, join the boards with a vertical cut. If you need help, use a plumb line.
- You can fill any gaps in the join with white Silicon. The Fascia and Barge Boards have a 5 year
- Warranty and require no painting with little maintenance.
